Instructor Clarification.*

Full-time; Main Dojo Instructor. Part-time; Temporary Instructor (in case of Main Instructor illness & holidays, etc.). Assistant Instructor; Operating under qualified instruction.

Conditions for membership.

All applicants must be practising a 'recognisable' form of **Wado Karate** upon application. Applicants **MUST** come from a 'credible' Wado source/generation. *All grades must be of Wado origination.* All non-Wado practising applicants/applications will be instantly rejected. Technical requirements **MUST** include: Wado Kihon Waza. All Pinan Kata (Shodan to Godan); Ku-Shanku, Nai-Hanchi, Seishan, Chinto. Kihon Gumite: (1 to 10).

New applicants: Once initially accepted you will be placed on a 'Provisional Membership' until application has been forwarded and accepted into full 'Associate Membership' by the IWF Executive Committee.

Affiliation Facilities within the British Wado Federation.

Types of Membership:

1. Associate Member (see options below - UK only): Fully Autonomous with own Constitution, Operational & Administrative Policies and Syllabus, etc. Associate members have full access to all facilities.*

2. Allied Member (see conditions below): Fully Autonomous with own Constitution, Insurance, Operational & Administrative Policies and Syllabus, etc. Chief Instructors have sole responsibility for their own group & individuals, therefore the International Wado Federation, and/or subsidiary affiliations, will not be held responsible or liable for any Allied Association or Group in membership. **Allied Membership is FREE!**

It is the responsibility of each Association/Group in membership to ensure that all their members are adequately insured. It is also the responsibility of each Chief Instructor/Director to ensure that all instructors are adequately insured, possess CRB (or equivalent) and have 1st Aid Certification.

*ASSOCIATE MEMBERS (3-scheme insurance/liability options)

Associate Members are self-governing 'autonomous' members and are insured through the **British Wado Federation** for cover in the practise of 'Traditional Wado Karate' within their own club/s only.

Insurance Cover Charges are based on the following criteria.

Option 2. Pay As You Go Scheme. Club/Group Licence/Membership Administration responsibility (clubs supply own licences to members). Member cost is @£5 per person per year, payable per member on a monthly Insurance Returns Basis. Please contact the BWF Licence Office for returns Sheets and Member-Chits, etc.

Option 3. Full Club Individual Licencing Office Scheme. BWF Licence £30/£25 per member. Members apply directly through the **British Wado Federation** for individual BWF Licences. All 'named' Club Level Instructors are included in insurance.

Important: All instructors & members must hold an up-to-date licence at all times, for complete cover.

ALLIED MEMBERSHIP

Allied Membership' to the **International Wado Federation**. Allied Members are self-governing 'autonomous' members and will be considered 'Allied Members' to the **International Wado Federation**. The **International Wado Federation** will have no control over Associate or Allied Members as they will have their own Constitution or Rules & Regulations for self-governance within their own Group/Association. NB: UK affiliations will have automatic 'allied' membership to the **British Wado Federation (BWF)**. **Allied Membership is FREE!**

NB: 'All-Styles' and 'Mixed Martial Arts' qualifications will not be accepted as qualifications of Wado Karate. Only credible **Wado karate** clubs and groups will be accepted into IWF membership. You do not have to leave your existing affiliation (*if any*) to join the **International Wado Federation**.

Additional conditions of membership: The **International Wado Federation** accepts organisations that have a democratic structure and that a board of directors are freely elected. All members must accept these rules and conditions of the IWF when applying for membership.

In respect to violation of Law/s, or Child Protection issues, etc., the relevant Associate Member Group will no longer be considered part of the **International Wado Federation**; *effective immediately upon awareness of such knowledge by the Committee of the IWF.*
