All applicants must be practising a 'recognisable' form of **Wado Karate** upon application. Applicants **MUST** come from a 'credible' Wado source/generation. *All grades must be of Wado origination.* All non-Wado practising applicants/applications will be instantly rejected. Technical requirements **MUST** include: Wado Kihon Waza. All Pinan Kata (Shodan to Godan); Ku-Shanku, Nai-Hanchi, Seishan, Chinto. Kihon Gumite: (1 to 10).

New applicants: Once initially accepted you will be placed on a 'Provisional Membership' until application has been forwarded and accepted into full 'Associate Membership' by the IWF Executive Committee.

The **International Wado Federation** will have no control over Associate or Allied Members as they will have their own Constitution or Rules & Regulations for self-governance within their own Group/Association. NB: UK affiliations will have automatic 'allied' membership to the **British Wado Federation (BWF)**.

NB: 'All-Styles' and 'Mixed Martial Arts' qualifications will not be accepted as qualifications of Wado Karate. **Only credible Wado karate clubs and groups will be accepted into IWF membership.** You do not have to leave your existing affiliation (*if any*) to join the **International Wado Federation**.

Additional conditions of membership: The International Wado Federation accepts organisations that have a democratic structure and that a board of directors are freely elected. All members must accept these rules and conditions of the IWF when applying for membership.

In respect to violation of Law/s, and/or Child Protection issues, etc., the relevant Associate Member Group will no longer be considered part of the International Wado Federation; effective immediately upon awareness of such knowledge by the Committee of the IWF.
