The Use of Temporary Visitors Membership.

Temporary Visitors' Membership is primarily for students who are in the area for a while, but wish to insure but not to licence, as their main Dojo (where they train and grade) is located elsewhere. Restrictions: Restrictions of use include; BWF Gradings, Advancement, Instructing (whether temporary or permanent), Competitions & Tournaments, etc.

Insurances - Cover is for all Wado Karate related activities organised within the UK membership of the British Wado Federation Governing Body. *Cover does not include training elsewhere and does not allow the use of live bladed weapons.*
